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**ADVANCE NOTIFICATION OF FILMING ACTIVITY –
WEST MALL, CLIFTON VILLAGE
FOR FILMING ON 13th & 14th AUGUST 2019**

Dear Local Business Owner(s),

We are writing to outline some proposals for filming due to take place in Clifton Village in mid-August. We are filming for a drama set in 1960s London and are keen to showcase some of the fantastic locations Bristol has to offer. We would like to work with you to ensure the filming is managed efficiently and whilst achieving the shots required for the programme, working to minimise any impact on the village. We are a local team and so especially keen to ensure we understand your concerns, in order to complete the filming in a way which is acceptable.

We have taken until now to fine tune and amend our requests, having liaised with Clifton BID and Bristol City Council Film Office. We are now sharing this with you as it is a revised summary of our requests. Whilst we have our own work to carry out, we are mindful you have your work to complete too. We have therefore amended our original requests and slimmed down the filming from several days to just two. We have worked with the Director to consolidate the schedule over the period, in order to complete exterior shots in the same sitting, meaning we can free up as much parking as possible. The enclosed sets out our latest plans. If when the filming occurs we can further reduce our requirements we will happily do that – we have no reason to keep bays vacant and coned off if we do not need them.

In order to safely facilitate the filming, we have applied to suspend six parking in West Mall just in from its junction with The Mall, in order to allow us to unload vehicles and work from them to internally dress a property on West Mall. We wish to make use of these spaces between Wednesday 7th August 0700 and Friday 9th August 1900. And again on Monday 12th August 0700 to approx. 1600 and on Thursday 15th August between 0700 and 1900. This will allow us to set-up and take down our props inside the property and avoid parking in bays which the public can use whilst visiting local shops. It also means we can keep double yellows clear for deliveries / collections.

We have applied to temporarily close West Mall from its junction with The Mall down to the 'no entry' point outside No. 14 West Mall between Monday 12th August at 1600 and Wednesday 14th August at 2200. This is to keep our vehicles away from The Mall as much as possible and reduce our impact there. This also allows us to place trolleys and other filming apparatus outside the property we are filming in, rather than spilling out too far beyond.

We have applied to temporarily suspend parking along The Mall on Tuesday 13th August between 1600 and 2200 from outside Clifton Village Butchers upto and including The Mall Pub and three spaces on Portland Street nearest to The Mall. This is for the widest shots we are looking to achieve and have kept this period as minimal as possible and scheduled it as late in the working day as we can manage whilst balancing a lack of dark at this time of the year and avoid going into late night filming therefore disturbing residents. We plan to dress in some 1960s cars along the street. If we are likely to see you shop or business we will be in touch as soon as possible if we haven't already, to discuss possible temporary sign covering if you are open to discussions about this.

We have applied to temporarily suspend parking from outside The Clifton Club up to and including No. 15 The Mall between 1800 Monday 12th August and Wednesday 14th August 2200. This is to allow us to place filming equipment outside the property we are filming in and manage vehicles within the shots.

We have applied to temporarily hold traffic for upto three minutes from The Mall at its junction with Princess Victoria Street and from Caledonia Place at its junction with The Mall between 1000 and 2200 on Tuesday 13th August and Wednesday 14th August. We have applied to temporarily hold traffic on Gloucester Row either side of its junction with the Mall. This is to allow us to safely film in the road for very short periods. The traffic control will not be throughout the whole day and if it is deemed to busy to carry out any traffic control, this will be stood down. These broad hours are the ones we have applied to manage but I must reiterate the traffic control will not be throughout the whole period. This system allows us to work without large road closures.

Please let us know if there is anything we can help you with or any matters which you wish to clarify. As a Bristol-based production and Locations Department, we are very aware of how busy the area can be and do not wish for our work to get in the way of yours. Our security team will be on hand throughout to assist with any queries. We continue to liaise with Clifton Bid, Bristol Film Office and Bristol City Council Parking Services. Avon & Somerset Police have been made aware of our proposals.

Signage confirming businesses are open as usual will be used throughout all working areas and our friendly security and traffic management teams will reiterate this to all members of the public. Please be reassured deliveries and couriers will not be sent elsewhere.

As a token of our thanks for local business support, we will arrange a gratuity payment to Clifton BID towards local funds.
